



All Groves students have a membership to Learning Ally, a national non-profit dedicated to helping blind, visually impaired and dyslexic students succeed in education.



Started in 1948 in the New York Public Library as Recording for the Blind, the organization utilized volunteers to record books for blinded veterans returning from WW II. Learning Ally now offers the world's largest collection of human-narrated audio textbooks and literature as well as solutions, support and community for parents, teachers and students.

Most of our students are already using Learning Ally and love it. Each student has their own login which takes them to their personal bookshelf. Using the Learning Ally Link program on their computers, or any of their other devices, lets them read any book on their bookshelf or choose more books to add.

Learning Ally Link is free and can be downloaded for Android, iOS, Mac, or Windows.

Books need to be downloaded to each device. This requires an internet connection. After the book is downloaded, no connection is needed. This is a fantastic way to read on long trips or just during free time.
